#### Dear Rate Payer:

The Sanford Water District will be filing a revised rate schedule with the Maine Public Utilities Commission, to be effective July 1, 2024. This filing is made under the provisions of 35-A MRSA Section 6104-B. The docket number for the filing is 2024-00066. Present rates were effective January 1, 2024.

#### Factors increasing our operating costs

The mission of the Sanford Water District is to provide safe, abundant, and affordable water to the residents of Sanford and Springvale. The proposed 1.5% increase on all rates will generate \$51,007.48 in additional revenue each year as shown below. This will help the District to keep rates current with rising costs and continue necessary infrastructure improvement projects.

### What will this do to my water bill?

The average residential customer is typically a family of four using 166 gallons of water per day. With the rate adjustment, the average residential customer's bill will increase by \$1.43 per quarter, less than \$0.50 per month.
